This year the Electoral Roll of the church is to be **RENEWED** [the roll is renewed every 6 years] in preparation for the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on Sunday 14th April after the Morning Service. In order to join the new Electoral Roll you must complete an application form: the forms will be available at the back of Church on the table in the Tower from Sunday 3rd March. Forms must be completed by Sunday 17th March.

Criteria to be on the Electoral Roll:

- be baptized
- be 16 or over or reach your 16th birthday in the next 12 months
- have regularly attended worship in the Parish during the last 6 months.
