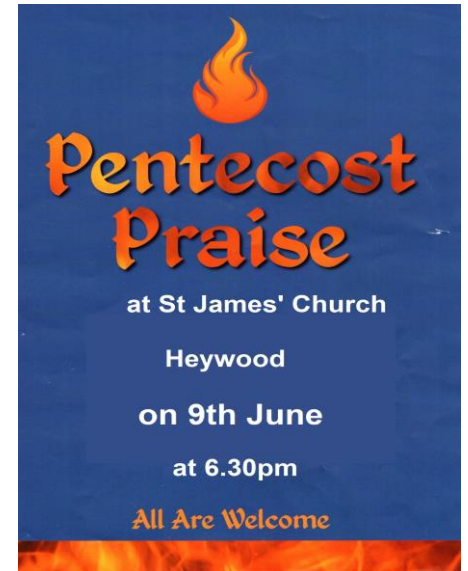

## Parish Quiet Day: A Time to Reflect Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> June

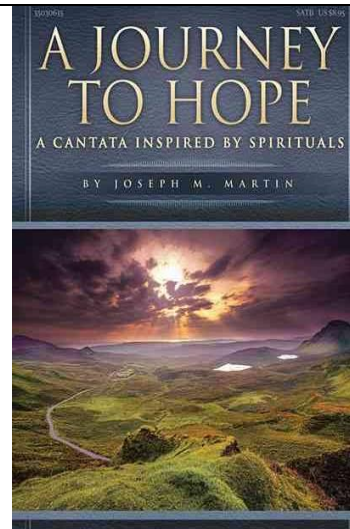
Would you like some time for yourself - a bit of peace and quiet and the
