All are welcome at a special Farewell Service for **Archdeacon Cherry Vann** at Manchester Cathedral today at 5.30pm. This is an opportunity to thank her for her wonderful ministry among us and to wish her well for the future, sending her on her way with our love and prayers as she takes up her new role as Bishop of Monmouth.

It has just been announced that there will be changes in the Archdeaconry arrangements in the Diocese. In due course, the Venerable David Sharples will become the new Archdeacon of Rochdale, whilst remaining a residentiary canon of the Cathedral. From 1 December 2019 the Venerable David Sharples will be given delegated authority in matters pertaining to the Archdeaconry of Rochdale. As support during this period, Bishop David has announced that the Reverend Canon Karen Smeeton is to become temporary Assistant Archdeacon. Canon Smeeton will remain Area Dean of Rochdale and Vicar of St Clement, Spotland and St George, Oakenrod.
