A message from the Vicar



Rochdale Foodbank, like everyone else, is affected by the current Corona virus situation. We introduced stringent hygiene procedures early but with new instructions on social isolation we have had to take more drastic action, especially as all of our volunteers are past retirement age. We will continue to distribute food but with minimal contact thus restricting the social interaction, care, signposting and prayer that we have been providing. Rochdale council staff are helping us in dealing with our clients.

We can accept donations, but these must be taken to the staff entrance of the council offices at No 1 Riverside and not directly to the Foodbank. Alternatively, please keep any donations at home as we will need to urgently restock when circumstances permit. You can also donate money if you wish via our website.
