Henry Willis & Sons Ltd: In the factory we have the Swell Underaction of the 1884 Father Willis (1928 & 1952 Henry III) organ from St. Aidan's Church, Sudden, Rochdale. The leather on the motors had become very stiff causing the action to become non responsive. The internal motors are extremely large at 22" long as they pull the pallets on three soundboards.
