Thanks to all who contributed to our Christian Aid Week collection in May. They benefitted by £374.

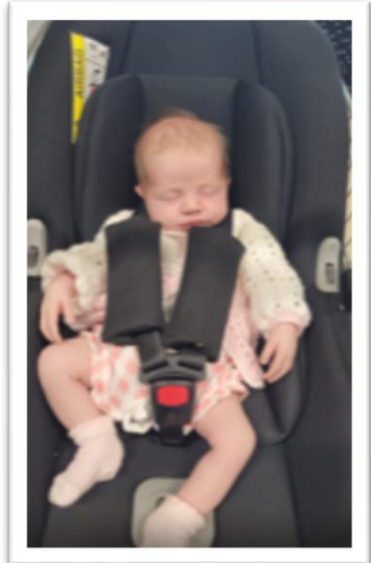
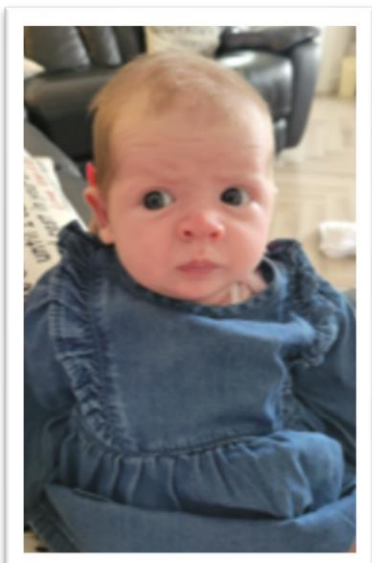
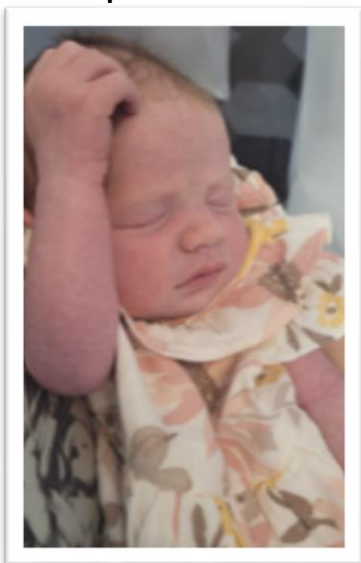
